## Welcome to CHBC...

On this second Sunday of Advent we light a candle representing **PEACE**. Isaiah spoke about the birth of a child, Jesus, who would be the Prince of Peace: "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, **Prince of Peace**." It would cost Jesus dearly to provide that peace for us. Isaiah continues, "But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that **brought us peace** was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed."
