CHBC Building Expansion Fund:

Thank you to those who are continuing to faithfully add 'blocks' to the expansion fund. These have varied in amounts and come in weekly, bi-monthly or monthly and together with some larger 'one-time' type donations totalled \$46,757 in 2009. We also added \$16,771 in interest last year. The first two Sundays of 2010 added \$805 (18 'blocks') and interest of \$562.50. This brings the total fund to \$684,503 and spending to date has been over \$600,000 which means we will make our first draw on the mortgage later this month. Full report with all details will be available in Feb. for the Annual General Meeting.
