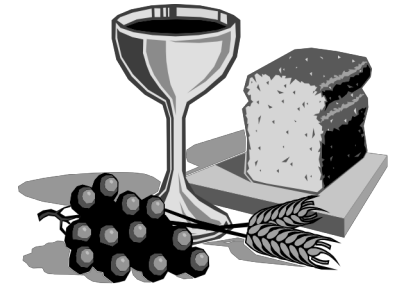

## Expansion Update:

### Building Expansion Fund Update

Is "the end" in sight?? Progress is now very evident and we are planning a celebration Sunday in June. Financially the project looks like being within targets. Funds have continued to come in with regular 'blocks' being added every Sunday and the total raised is now at \$692,416. Delays have given opportunity for this amount to keep rising! Thanks also to all our volunteers who have been making savings on the expenses side. Expenses paid out as of Apr 25 were \$988,642 and our mortgage stood at \$240,000. The sixth draw is due shortly and this will increase the mortgage to \$420,000 so it is looking hopeful that we can keep the final figure somewhere between \$600,000 & \$650,000 – almost \$100,000 less than we anticipated when we voted to proceed with the project. Praise the Lord and keep praying for the finalization details to fall into place. If you have questions please talk to any of the building committee members.
