Katimavik Volunteer Youth Service

Jennica Rawstron of our church is a project leader for Katimavik, and is looking for billets for this project. Participants are 17-21 and are youth from all across Canada. They volunteer full time in the community and live together in a house, while working on a number of competencies through experiential learning. As part of their 3 month stay in PG (and later in other Canadian communities), they will be billeted in families for nine days. Billet families host one Katimavik participant for nine days – Nov 27 –Dec 6. Billet families are given \$90 to help cover food/gas for the participant during their stay. Participants will continue to go to their volunteer jobs Mon-Fri during the day, and are expected to take part in every day family activities/chores the rest of the time.
