## CHBC Building Expansion:

**Thank you** for your continued giving to the fund and also to those who are and have been involved in volunteering their time and talents on the project. Another 20 blocks in the last two weeks now bring the total to \$664,715 and this month we will add a further \$2174 in Interest. Gross spending to date has been \$433,827 but we will get over \$9000 of that (GST) back in January 2010. This means we can pay the third draw (\$183,000) out of existing funds but next month will probably need to make our first use of mortgage funds – or can we raise enough to put this off until January and so reduce the overall amount we will need to borrow?? At this point in time we are a bit over budget due to some changes that resulted in extra costs but continuing volunteer labour should produce reductions that will off set these and the hope/goal is to complete the project at or below budget.
